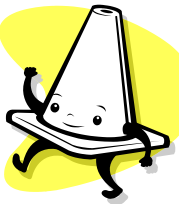


February/March Virtue – CARING

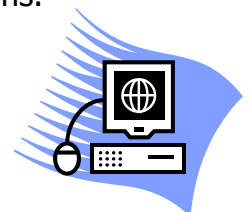
